Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Christ is Risen! He is Risen Indeed! Alleluia!

This litany always fills me with a sense of joy and wonder. The joy that Christ was indeed resurrected; the joy that comes from knowing my sins are forgiven because Christ took on the sins of all and died in our place; the wonder that God loves you and me so much that God gave us the gift of Jesus, who willingly died on the cross to save us.

Easter is a time of new life. New life springing forth from the ground, newborn life of the animals of God's kingdom. It is also a time of new life in the ministries of UFLC. Two of those ministries are in the form of committees, one of which is Stewardship. And I'm guessing you either just rolled your eyes, or gave a great big sigh, while thinking, "Ugh, not that!" It is a common response. We generally don't want to talk about money – especially asking people to give more. It tends to make us squirm in our seats. I would ask that you continue reading and consider the following:



God expects us to freely return a portion of our provisions to him in thanksgiving.

Stewardship does not refer simply to money. The provisions given to us by God come in the form of time we can give, talents we can share, *and* treasures we can bestow.
