Dear Sisters and Brothers in Christ,

As I look across my office, I see an Easter wreath hanging on my mirror behind the door. It's hanging there, waiting to be hung on the outside of my door in celebration of Easter. I toyed with the idea of hanging it on my door right away when it was given to me earlier in the week, but it didn't feel right to do so just yet.

We decorate our homes in anticipation of a holiday, often then taking them down soon after the holiday is over. More so with Easter than with other holidays, this seems a little what my Nana would have called 'hinnasfadish' (backwards in PA Dutch). To jump directly to Easter without first experiencing the journey of Lent leaves so much out.

It skips over us experiencing all that Jesus experienced on His journey to the cross. It skips over experiencing the opposition from the religious leaders of the day; it skips over the betrayal of Jesus by one of His own twelve disciples; it skips over the humiliation He was subjected to in the hours before and during His crucifixion. We miss Christ willingly going to the cross for you and me. We miss the fear the disciples must have felt when Jesus was arrested. We miss their grief when Jesus was placed in the tomb and the stone was rolled to seal it shut.

If we look past all of that and jump to Easter, how can we truly take it all in and feel the depth of what Jesus did for each of us? We miss the incredible sacrifice made for us in order to vanquish mortal death so that we might have eternal life with God! *That* is not something we want to miss!

Join us for worship during Holy Week, beginning with Palm Sunday. Come and sit with it, experience it, soak it all in. Let the weight of the events of Good Friday go with you as you leave worship. Easter morning will be all the sweeter as you come to worship and sing, 'Christ is risen! Alleluia! Sing his praises! Alleluia! Christ is risen from the dead!', celebrating the new life we have received through Christ our Savior!

## MARCH 2ND OFFERING - COPS'N'KIDS EASTON

The Easton Police Department conducts a program called Cops-n-Kids in conjunction with the Easton Area School District that sends Easton Police Officers into the classrooms of fifth and sixth graders in the Easton Area Middle School. The Officers "teach" classes about what it is

like to be a Police Officer. The program culminates with a field day outside with many specialty units of local police departments, emergency medical services, medical helicopter units and fire departments demonstrating their capabilities. The program was developed to build a bond with students in the classroom setting and demonstrate the various emergency responder careers available to them.


